FESTIVALPARK WERCHTER DO'S & DON'TS

The safety of concert and festival goers, artists and their crew, employees and neighbouring residents is always our highest priority. We have a robust safety policy. With this summer's festival season in mind, we have organised different meetings with the local and federal police and the local and provincial authorities in recent months and weeks. A set of measures will be implemented. Clear directives and guidelines are established on what to allow or disallow into the Festivalpark. Read all about it in this useful document.

The measures taken must not impact the festivities. We will do everything to make sure the additional checks run as smoothly as possible. We thank you in advance for your understanding, for your spontaneous cooperation during the controls, and for the extra effort demanded. Festivals and concerts are a celebration. Enjoy!

CHECK-IN

Before you can pass through the metal detector, you will be asked to place a number of items in a cardboard box provided by our staff to facilitate a brief visual screening by our security agents. These items will include non-drinkable liquids and gels in packaging up to 100ml – with a maximum 1 liter in total, cell phones or smart phones, electronic equipment, small cameras and bunches of keys. The following do not need to go in the bags: jewelry, watches, belts, small change, shoes.

NOT ALLOWED IN THE VENUE

This list can be extended or modified at any time by the organisers.

- Professional photo/film/video/sound recording equipment
- Drinks (alcoholic & non-alcoholic)
- Drinking glasses
- Cans
- Cartons
- Drugs
- Fireworks
- Weapons
- Knives
- Explosives
- Sharp objects
- Benches/folding chairs (except these folding chairs – [example](#))
- Inflatable objects (paddling pools, balls, chairs, etc.)
- Non-drinkable liquids and gels in packaging larger than 100ml
- Tents and other camping equipment
- Tripods and selfie sticks
- Laser pens
- Drones
- Laughing gas
- Steel drinking bottles/drinking cups/mess tins (empty reusable plastic water bottles are allowed)
- Large backpacks (>45 cm height >30l volume)
- Gas and gas burners
- Candles
- Parasols and umbrellas with pointed ends
- Plastic or wooden boxes
- Polystyrene blocks
- Bicycle pumps
- Animals (except guide dogs for the visually impaired)
- Flyers, stickers, posters and other promotional material
- Any other object which can be considered dangerous by the organisers

PACK LIGHTLY, DO NOT BRING ANY UNNECESSARY BELONGINGS. IF POSSIBLE, LEAVE BAGS AND BACKPACKS AT HOME.
